WHAT TO DO...

1. Read the information all about forces on pages three and four of Science 1.0.1.
2. Create an eye-catching image which shows an activity, such as a favourite sport, in which forces are involved. For your image, you could take a photo, draw a picture or cut out a photo from your newspaper.
3. Write words about the forces acting on the people and objects in your image and display arrows to show the direction the forces are acting in.

DETAILS

- Remember to include all your details with your poster - name, age, school, and school address.
- The poster must be original and must not have been previously published.
